

## How to Login to your NWAL Account Online!



1 Navigate to <a href="https://www.northwaleslibrary.org/">https://www.northwaleslibrary.org/</a>






Click the "Library Card Number" field. Enter your library card number that starts with "2508" or "2239" in this box. You will need to enter the ENTIRE number.
